Cotutelle

PhD studies with dual supervision of dissertations (known under the French name cotutelle) take place on the basis of **cooperation** between Charles University and a university abroad. **Joint supervision** of a dissertation is carried out by **two supervisors** – one from each involved institution – and the doctoral candidate spends a part of the PhD programme at **both institutions**. This cooperation contributes significantly to the **internationalization** of PhD studies, and in the long run, to the integration of science and research at the faculties into an **international environment**.
